HOW TO BECOME A FAMILY & CONSUMER SCIENCES TEACHER

SINGLE SUBJECT CREDENTIAL

The Home Economics/Family & Consumer Sciences Credential authorizes the teaching of courses in all three FCS industry sectors:

- Hospitality, Tourism, & Recreation
- Education, Child Development & Family Services
- Fashion and Interior Design

To qualify for this credential:

- Have a university degree in Family & Consumer Sciences Education (available at CSU Sacramento and CSU Northridge)

OR

- Have an FCS-related degree (Nutrition & Food, Hospitality Management, Child Development, etc) and pass the CSET subject competency test.

ADVANTAGES OF THE SINGLE SUBJECT CREDENTIAL

- Become a highly qualified educator through fifth-year education courses and student teaching.
- A university degree ensures a well-rounded educator.
- FCS Single Subject student teachers are hired immediately, sometimes as paid intern student teachers.
- Full educators and benefits (CA teachers annual salaries range from \$48,000 to \$110,000)

DESIGNATE SUBJECTS CTE CREDENTIAL

The Designated Subjects CTE Credential authorizes the teaching of courses in one FCS industry sectors:

- Hospitality, Tourism, & Recreation
- Education, Child Development & Family Services
- Fashion and Interior Design

To qualify for this credential:

- Complete 48-semester units of postsecondary vocational training related to the industry sector AND have one year (1000 hours) of industry-related work experience

OR

- Have a high school diploma and three years of industry-related work experience
